OVERTIME:

- If the score is tied at the end of regulation, the game goes to overtime. A coin flip determines which team has the initial possession of the overtime. Two minutes will be placed on the game clock. The game winner is the first team to score 2 points in the overtime period (Two 1-point baskets, Two 1-point free-throws, OR One 2-point basket – both feet behind the arc). THIS IS NOT "WIN-BY-2" Meaning, win by 2-point margin. If only ONE point has been scored at the end of the 2 minute overtime period, the team scoring the point will be the winner.
- If still tied During Pool Play / Season Games: THE GAME WILL END IN A TIE (if ZERO points have been scored, or if both teams scored only 1 point at the end of the 2 minute overtime).
- If still tied During Tournament Games: a SUDDEN-DEATH FREE THROW SHOOTOUT will determine the winner of the game (if ZERO points have been scored, or if both teams scored only 1 point at the end of the 2 minute overtime period). FORMAT FOR SHOOTOUT: the winner of a coin flip chooses to shoot first or shoot second. The three players from each team remaining on the court at the end of the overtime period will be the only players to shoot for their team. The three players for each team will rotate, alternating teams with each shot per round. Each team will shoot in each round UNTIL ONE TEAM SCORES UNANSWERED (this rule may be revised before the Tournament).
