Safety and Health

 - They should introduce themselves
 - Call BHS Ops Manager if not present
- Locate Facility AED
 - EMT/Athletic trainer carries one.
 - PAAC and YCSC at concession area.

For Home Games:

- ☐ Table, Horn, Scorebook, Game Clocks
- ☐ Scorekeeper & Timekeeper
- ☐ Check Field Condition lines, cones



Entering Line-up:

- Record Line-up in Pencil
 - players names and official roster jersey #
- If Player wearing different jersey for game day, coach or scorekeeper will move official roster jersey number to end of name
- Enter game jersey number here
- For a JV player playing up: enter JV and JV jersey # after name



Home Team Coach Responsibility

- Home Coach provides Official Timekeeper and Scorekeeper*
- Home Team provides Table, Horn, Game Timer, and Official Scorebook**
- Ensures field is in proper condition for play; including cones and lines.

Understanding the Timekeeper's Penalty Management Role

- Player must kneel or sit in front of score table
- Coach may sub player in box starting at 10 sec left in penalty time.
- Timers count down loudly from 10 secs, at zero yell "Released"



Understanding Scorekeeping Responsibilities

 Before game: Get Scorebook from coach. Verify rosters, coaches and player #s

 <u>During game</u>: Record goals, assists, penalties, and time outs





Coaches - After Game:

Check recorded roster and score for accuracy

Be ready to submit image* of completed

official scorebook pa



Selection Process

- Coaches will nominate own players
- Coaches will vote for selection of other teams' players
- Coaches encouraged to note and submit the most impactful players of the opposing team in a postgame report – D, M, A, and overall.
- Coaches encouraged to submit accurate stats on own players after each game.

League Position on Recording Statistics

- The League encourages accurate recording and online reporting of player statistics
- Timekeeping and scorekeeping come first in priority.
 - Goals, assists, and games played recorded by scorekeeper
- Additional statistics taken and entered if enough volunteers
 - Shots, Ground Balls, Caused Turnovers, Face-offs taken, Face-offs won, Goalies Saves and Goals Allowed





Entering Stats on HRLax Website

- Statisticians tally the statistics and give to coach
- Designated person enters stats onto website
 - Could be coach, assistant coach, team manager
- Log onto www.hrlax.com
 - First select correct Team from Team drop-down
 - Then select Results from Team drop-down menu




