### **JUNIOR INFORMATION**

- High School players can officiate youth games! The Junior officials must be 2 years older than the age they are officiating
- Great way to make extra money! (\$35 to \$45 per game and officials are typically assigned 5-15 games a season or more)
- Junior games are on weekends so they do not conflict with high school games!

### **REQUIRED TRAINING**

Each Junior official **must** complete the following **5 tasks** in order to be assigned games:

- 8 classroom hours (pick either the South Bay training, East Bay or Sacramento) plus 1 online course: This course is accessed after you receive your USL membership.
