Game Format:

- Please have a coach check in at the NCJLA table at least 45 minutes prior to your first game.
- Rules sheet and info sheet will be taped to the tables.
- Scoresheets will be provided.
- Each team must provide 1 adult scorekeeper/timer.
- Higher seeded team is the "home" team and supplies the NOCSAE balls.
- Winner brings score sheet to the NCJLA table.

Overtime:

- Overtime: 2 min rest period, alternate possession carries over into overtime, then a 3 min sudden victory full team playing period. No timeouts during 3 min playing period.
- If no score after Overtime: 2 min rest period, alternate possession carries over, then a Braveheart, three girls from each team plus a goalie play until a team wins. No timeouts during Braveheart.


