Dear Team Presidents,

As part of our application to the Northern California Junior Lacrosse Association we have been asked to set in writing certain definitions of our potential territory, school districts, and willingness to release and accept players from outside our defined area as well recruiting territory. Any player that previously played for any other club but is in the proposed Rocklin Youth Lacrosse area is not required to play for a RYLC team nor is required to seek any formal release as they are grandfathered to stay at the club they previously played for. RYLC will share any and all registration information for both the season and clinics with adjacent clubs as well.


For the purposes of the growth of our club we propose to accept players only from the cities of Rocklin and Lincoln. This includes zip codes 95765 and 95767 for Rocklin and 95648 for Lincoln. We plan on only recruiting from the school districts of Rocklin and Lincoln (Rocklin Unified and Western Placer Unified.) In terms of any marketing or notices sent to potential players through the schools we will only send information through the school districts listed above.

Our primary fields are as yet determined but we will only be using fields that are either part of the Rocklin Unified field system or Rocklin Parks and Recreation. As of the writing of this letter we are planning on using the fields at Sunset Ranch Elementary, Springview Middle School, and Whitney High School.


We plan to register a boys u12 team with NCJLA and potentially a girls u14 team for the 2018 season and gradually increase to include a team in each NCJLA division.
