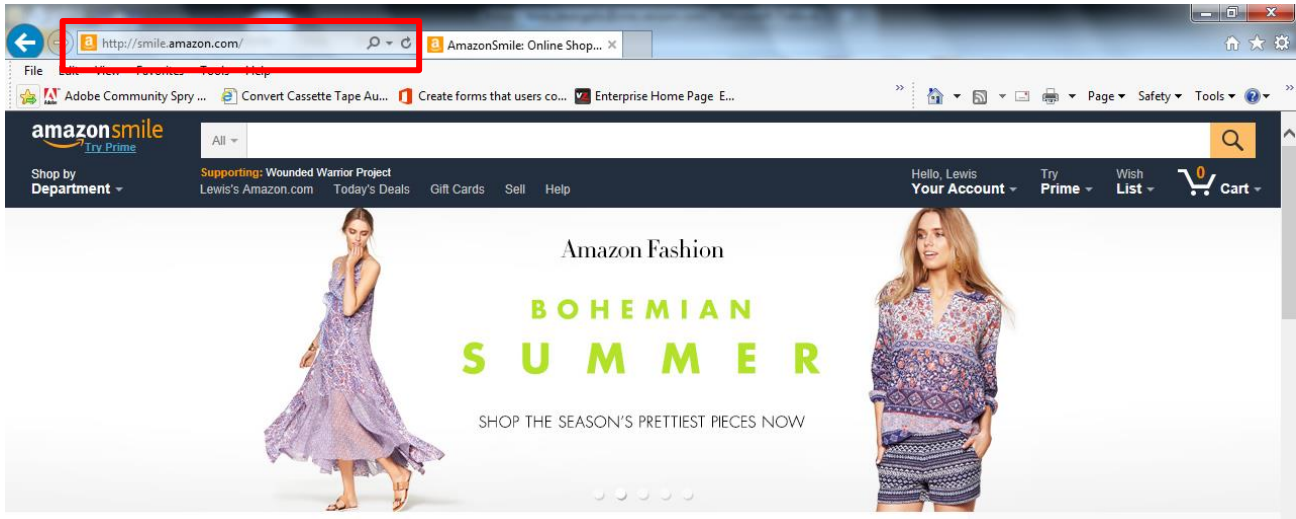


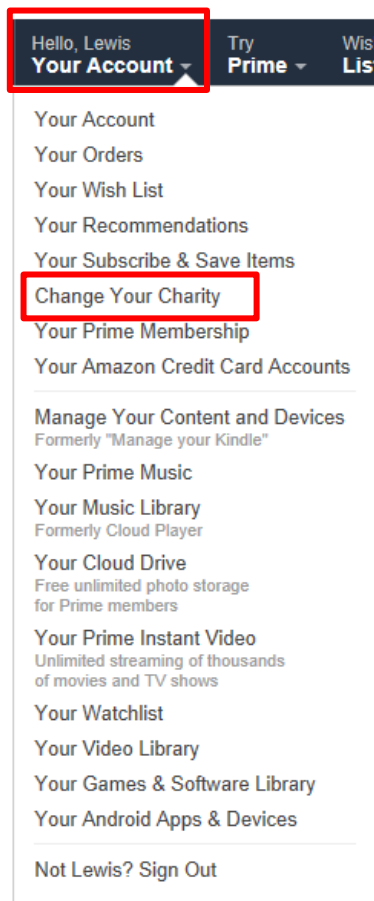
How to Use Smile.Amazon.com to Support the BBC

Instead of navigating to amazon.com in your web browser, navigate to smile.amazon.com.



Once you are logged into your account you will see the Your Account menu. You will also see a like to designate or change your charity.



Type "Branchburg Baseball Club" in the Search box and press the "Search" button.
