

2019 FRAMINGHAM YOUTH HOCKEY SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Framingham Youth Hockey will be offering scholarship awards to qualified, graduating high school seniors who have been members of Framingham Youth Hockey and will be attending an accredited 2- or 4- Year College after graduation or a preparatory school to further their education after graduation.

Awards will be granted to students graduating from high school this year who have been an active participant of the Framingham Youth Hockey Program for a minimum of three years and are in good financial standing with the youth hockey program. These years need not be consecutive. Applicants who are not currently playing organized hockey or who have left FYH to promote their own personal advancement of hockey are eligible to apply. Applicant's school records must indicate a probability of success in a chosen field of higher education. Schools of choice must be accredited as either a 2- or 4-year program or an accredited preparatory school. The scholarship committee seeks a well-rounded student to be a scholarship recipient. Dedicated commitments to FYH, school and community will weigh heavily in award selection. In addition to these requirements, applicants will be asked to provide:

1. an essay stating why FYH should award this scholarship to you
2. a copy of your most recent high school transcript
3. a letter of recommendation from a high school faculty member
4. a letter of recommendation from their FYH coach or someone associated with the program.
