ANNUAL PLAYER RECOGNITION AWARDS

The Twin Boro Football board is excited to announce a new series of annual awards that will recognize players for their seasonal contributions to their team and to the league.

LEAGUE AWARDS (1 for SUNDAY levels, 1 for SATURDAY levels)

Each award below is granted to a single athlete or individual in the league each year. All candidates must be nominated by their respective coaching staff, with a single nomination from each team submitted to the board for review. The board will assess all nominations and will collectively select a winner for each one.

Athlete of the Year	Regardless of team record, this athlete must demonstrate exceptional athletic ability across multiple elements of the game; their skills should include athletic performance as well as the ability to demonstrate proper form as instructed by their coaches.

Sportsman of the Year	Candidates for this award must consistently demonstrate true sportsmanship and leadership throughout the course of the season. Regardless of their physical skills or their role on their respective team, these individuals should be considered by their teammates to be a player who reflects the true spirit of competition and sportsmanship.

Coach of the Year	<p>This award recognizes an individual coach who exemplifies the true spirit of mentoring youth players and creating an environment for his team that is fun, instructional, fair, and competitive. Candidates for this award must show consistent commitment to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ...teaching their players the game of football, and to teaching good sportsmanship on and off the field• ...developing practice plans that comply with league rules, stimulate interest in the position or the game, and serve to improve player safety and performance• ...leading with selfless character and fostering the individual players on his team with equality and common interest

LEAGUE AWARDS (tackle players only)

Rules:

- Each tackle level team may submit ONE player or coach nomination for each League Award.
- Individual players, parents, or coaches can only win the award ONCE during their tenure in the Twin Boro program
- All nominations must be sent to the TBB Board Secretary – Brian Coughlin (brian.coughlan@mac.com) NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, OCTOBER 27th.
- The board will review all nominations, and will decided on the winner for each award.
- A single team may win multiple awards, but the emphasis will be on ensuring distribution of awards across multiple levels.
- Coaches will be notified of winners on or around November 5th. League wide emails will be sent out to announce the winners on November 12th.

TEAM AWARDS

These awards are granted to one player at each level. They are selected by the collaborative discretion of the full coaching staff for each team.

No nominations are required for these. Simply submit your 4 final winners by the submission deadline and they will be included in the league wide announcements on November 12th.

Please do not deviate from the the names and descriptions below, as the league will be providing specific trophies for each.

Most Improved Player <i>(tackle levels only)</i>	This individual must demonstrate significant improvement in skill and execution over the course of the current season, or compared to the prior season. Improvement should be a result of effort and determination rather than increase in size or growth

Lineman of the Year <i>(tackle levels only)</i>	Candidates must demonstrate excellent performance at any of the tackle to tackle offensive line positions, and must show continued determination to play and exceed at this position

Grizzly Bear Award <i>(tackle levels only)</i>	This award is reserved for the player that shows continued effort and focus in practice throughout the course of the season; candidates must demonstrate ability to make adjustments recommended by coaches; and must demonstrate personal commitment to improving their own performance and contribution to the team.
