

TWIN BORO CHEERLEADER UNIFORM POLICY updated March 2021

Print, Read in Full and Sign Policy before Camp

Your child will receive a cheerleading uniform from the Twin Boro Cheerleading organization for the 2021 cheerleading season which will consist of a **vest, skirt and jacket**. Please remember that these uniforms are used for many years to come and it is important for us to keep each uniform in the condition that it is received. We appreciate your help in keeping the uniforms looking new.

A. Uniform Care:

It is important for you to know that you and your child are responsible for all **three pieces of the uniform** since it is on loan to your child for the cheerleading season.

1. If the uniform is **lost or stolen**, or returned **with any marks or damage**, you are responsible for the cost to replace the uniform. This includes stains, pulls, make-up (foundation, lipstick, blush etc.), holes or tears.
2. Cheerleaders are **not permitted** to eat or drink any food that causes stains while wearing their uniform. Such items include (but not limited to) **hot dogs and/or hamburgers/cheeseburgers with ketchup and/or mustard, French fries with ketchup, pizza, hot chocolate, soda, fruit juices, colored Gatorade etc.** If your daughter needs to eat these foods, please do so after the game and change out of her uniform.
3. If your daughter needs to wear make-up, please apply it after dressing and wipe-off it off before the vest is removed. It is important to note that make-up does not wash well. If you can avoid using, we would appreciate it.
4. If the uniform is damaged, please note that you will **NOT** be allowed to retain the damaged uniform even after a replacement uniform has been purchased and paid. **All uniforms (vest, skirt & jacket) are the sole property of the Twin Boro Cheerleading Organization.**

B. Policies:

1. Parents of cheerleaders must sign the uniform release when you present your **\$150 refundable deposit check** which is due the **first day of cheerleading camp** and will be returned once the uniform is received back at the end of the season. Please make check payable to: **CPAA-Cheerleading** In order to expedite your uniform deposit at camp, please have your check **completed and signed** prior to that morning so that we may process you quickly.
2. Uniform will be distributed to each cheerleader by the **second** day of Cheerleading Camp once the uniform deposit is received and the uniform release is signed by the parent/guardian.
3. If you receive a uniform that is **dirty or damaged**, please bring it to the attention of the Uniform Committee (*Amy Golier at giggleface76@msn.com*) in person along with the uniform no later than **Wed., August 11**, ito resolve the issue and not to be charged a cleaning fee or replacement fee at the end of the season. **After August 11**, it will be assumed that any damage to the uniform occurred during the 2021 season and will be your responsibility.
4. Care instructions are as follows:
 - Machine Wash COLD & Gentle - separate from any other wash
 - Air Dry Only – DO NOT place in a dryer
 - NO IRONING – Heat will melt and damage the uniform
 - DO NOT Dry-Clean

5. The uniform (vest, skirt, or jacket) is to be worn at football games at the time your child is cheering. The uniform is **NOT** to be worn to practices (except Picture Day), school or as a Halloween costume. Please note that this policy **does not** apply to Spirit Wear (fleece jacket, t-shirts, pajama pants etc.)! Spirit Wear are items that you purchase and own.

C. Uniform Return:

1. **It is your responsibility to return your uniform in CLEAN condition;** the Coaches do not collect and return uniforms. However, **the uniform can be returned by a friend or family member.** There will be 2 drop-off dates to return cheerleading uniforms (these dates are subject to change):

Wednesday, November 10 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm Storage Facility, 50 North Road, Chester	Saturday, November 13 10:00 am – 12:00 pm Storage Facility, 50 North Road, Chester
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2. Late Fee Costs

Late fees will be charged to any parent/guardian who does **not** return **all 3 pieces** of the uniform by the required return date.

Uniform received after 11/20/21 - \$50

Uniform received by or after 12/1/21 - \$150

3. Cleaning Costs

All pieces of the uniform should be washed before returning. Any piece of the uniform **not** returned in a clean condition will not be acceptable and will be subject to a **\$30 cleaning fee**.

4. **Replacement Costs** - If the uniform is **lost or stolen**, or returned **with any marks or damage**, you are responsible for the cost to replace the uniform:

Vest - \$130

Skirt - \$100

Jacket - \$100

5. Deposit Checks

Your uniform deposit check will be returned to you once all pieces of the uniform have been returned in the proper condition. If your uniform does not meet the above requirements for uniform returns, your deposit check will be cashed on **Wednesday, December 1, 2021** to cover the late fee, replacement cost and/or a cleaning fee.

6. Unpaid Fees

Unpaid fees will prevent a cheerleader(s) from participating in the program in subsequent years until the fee(s) is paid.
