

AHYAA response to Positive Covid exposures

In the case of a positive Covid exposure/ illness or a positive test, immediately notify your manager. The manager will notify the league representative and relay the information across the division. (without identifying the affected individual). If you or your child tested positive contact your local health authority to allow them to start the process of contact tracing and other possible action/steps. Individuals who test positive for Covid should self-isolate and not participate in sports for 14 days. Prior to returning to AHYAA baseball/softball, obtain a note from their healthcare provider releasing them to full participation.

Individuals who have had close contact with someone who test positive, such as a household member should self isolate for at least 14 days.

FAQ

Q: If I have had close contact to a positive Covid -19 individual, how long should I wait to participate?

A: 14 days or have a negative test result. Unless the individual that tested positive is a member of your household then wait 14 days from the positive test result of your family member to resume participation
