



12U & 10U GSL Team Evaluation Protocols

Evaluation Format

- Teams will compete in the division (North, South, East) they requested prior to team information deadline.
- Teams will play 4 games (only) within division.
- 12U Division will play 1st weekend. 10U Division will play 2nd weekend.
- If your team may be able to compete at a higher division consider evaluating 1 division up.
- Teams are encouraged to play independent games prior to team placement meeting to determine best division.
- Representatives from each organization are required to attend Team Placement meeting week following team evaluation weekends.

Coaches Instructions

- Home Coach starts game sheet and gives to Away Coach. The Away Coach gives to timekeeper.
- Adhere game sheet stickers to game sheet. If you have games back to back then do both games ahead of time.
- Locker room assignments are on the rink board.
- Get in and out of locker rooms quickly. If necessary, you may need share the locker room. Tell the players to leave expensive items at home.
- Work with refs to keep games moving
- Don't back off, play hard for 30 minutes
- Don't forget to inspect and sign the game sheet at conclusion of game.
- Home Coach is to get white copy of game sheet. Away Coach gets yellow copy. Refs gets pink if they want it. Remaining copies are to be filed in the rink office by the timekeeper.
- Home Coach is required to submit photo of game sheet to gslhockeystats@gmail.com within 12 hours of the game.
- Home Coach must enter the score electronically on GSL website within 6 hours (instructions can be found [here](#)).
- Teams do not need to pay ref or timekeeper. The GSL has made these arrangements.

Game format (All divisions) 30 minutes total

- Teams will have 1 1/2 minute warm up
- After warm up the game clock will be set for 25 minutes running time
- After game teams will have 2 minutes for handshakes
- Teams must leave the rink quickly to make way for the next teams

Penalty duration:

- Minor 1:30
- Major 3:00
- Misconduct 6:00
- Any suspensions (game misconducts) must be served next game with no exceptions. These have to be marked on the game sheet.

- All game incidents including Game Misconduct, 3 Penalty ejections, and Match Penalties occurring in any game whether league, non-league, or tournament must be reported to the GSL with 6 hours using the [Online Form](#).
