

Student Athlete Code of Conduct

FALL 2018

This Code of Conduct is applicable to all players associated with the Westview Lacrosse program and representing Westview High School (WHS). It will be upheld at practices, games, while traveling, at fundraisers, and any other time in which a player is representing the Program or School.

Honor: I will conduct myself in a way that shows respect to parents, teachers, administrators, coaches, teammates and opponents at all times, both on and off the field.

I will conduct myself at all times, in a manner that will reflect positively on Westview Lacrosse, Westview High School and will not discredit or bring disgrace to my school, team or myself. I pledge practice a healthy lifestyle on and off the field. This includes my commitment to not use, possess, sell, or distribute tobacco, alcoholic beverages, narcotics or other illegal drugs. I commit myself to play fair and be a good winner as well as a good loser, to win with grace and lose with dignity.

Academics: I understand that to participate on a Westview Lacrosse team I must be enrolled in at least 5 classes, be passing ALL classes during each semester, have at least 2.0 GPA.

I have read and understand the Beaverton School District Academic Improvement Program, which requires athletes be enrolled in and passing ALL classes during each semester, have a 2.0 GPA and progressing towards graduation to be eligible for participation.

Discipline: I realize that I am making a commitment to this team and as such will attend all practices and scheduled team events. If I am unable to attend an event, I will notify one of the coaches in advance. If I miss an event unexcused, I realize there will consequences for my actions.

I understand that I am making the commitment to fully support the team and coaches. Any conduct that is detrimental to esprit de corps of the team (i.e. negative attitude, comments or actions) will result in reduced playing time, suspension and possible expulsion from the team.

Team: Westview Lacrosse is a team sport based on individual and team skills. Successful teams are founded upon committed individuals. I understand that practice is crucial to my own development as a lacrosse player and to the team's success; any failure to hustle 110% through all activities, drills and scrimmages, may affect the amount of playing time. I pledge to commit the time necessary to acquire and improve my individual skills. This means improving my skills outside of team practice, pursuing my own physical conditioning routine in addition to team practice and learning team plays.

Rules: I understand that the Westview Lacrosse program follows and enforces the NFHS Lacrosse rules, the OHSLA and OGLA SOPs at all times. As a player, I agree to abide by these rules and SOPs. I understand these rules and SOPs are in place for player safety, sportsmanship and to Honor the Game; and if not followed, there are consequences to me as well as the Team.

My Parent/Guardian & I have read the above and agree to abide by the Westview Lacrosse Code of Conduct. We understand that failure to follow any part of this code of conduct will result in disciplinary action which may include reduced playing time, suspension from games, loss of Varsity letter, and/or expulsion from the Westview Lacrosse team.
