

# CONCESSION STAND OPERATIONS

Before the game:

- Pull out the grill
- Hang the American Flag. It is on the shelf and the hook to hang it is on the wall behind the door.
- Start up the nacho machine if it isn't going. It lasts for up to 6 days warm. To dispense, push the green button once! It is set to dispense the right amount of cheese each time. Please do not hold the button in.
- Put the trash cans out. Make sure there are bags loaded in them.
- Set out the basket of candy
- Take the chocolate candy out of the fridge and place on shelves
- Check to see if there are any defrosted burgers or hot dogs. If not, take frozen meat out of the freezer and start defrosting it.
- Put cones at the bottom of the cement drive
- If the weather dictates, fill the hot water warmer if needed and start coffee
- Wear gloves to prepare and handle non-packaged food
- Start the grill up by the 5<sup>th</sup> inning. Begin making the hamburgers, cheeseburgers and hotdogs around the bottom of the 5<sup>th</sup>. Wrap the cooked items in foil wrap and put them in one of the insulated bags.  
**Charger ball players can pick any meal deal with any drink of their choice for free.**

After the game:

- Re-stock the fridge with pop, water and Gatorade
- Put chocolate candy in the fridge
- Empty and clean out the coffee pot and water warmer
- Make sure all food is out of the microwaves
- Make sure all food is picked up and put away as much as possible
- Close the front and put the boards in place (short one on top)
- Make sure the gas is turned off on the grill and pull it back into the stand
- Make sure the American flag has been put away.
- Turn off the lights

# **POST GAME RESPONSIBILITIES**

## **FOR PARENTS NOT WORKING CONCESSIONS THAT DAY**

Each parent at the game should have some type of duty to complete before heading home. The concession folks have plenty to do so please chip in accordingly.

- Empty all trash and take it to the dumpsters
  - This includes the ones between the stands and near the dugouts
  - If necessary, rinse them so they don't start to stink
- Sweep off the stands of seeds and peanut shells
- Pick up the trash around the stands and snack shack
- Check the toilet paper status in the port-t-let (more is in the snack shack)
- Sweep out front of the snack shack and the entryway
- Load the recycle items and see who wants to take them home
- Take down the American flag. Fold it is best you can and place it back on the shelf and the hook back on the wall.
- Anything else that you seem to think needs done. You don't need approval or special authority to clean up. We need to take pride in our field and the players will follow our lead.
