Treasurer's Report – Financials for calendar year are complete. We had less revenue than previous year, but more profitable, due to field costs and insurance costs going down. Woody going to send out a budget template for all sports coordinators to complete and send to him at least two months prior to sport registration starting.

Administrative Assistants Report – DC going to turf Challenger #1, and turf the infields of #2 and #3 this summer. Work to begin around June 1 on CH #1. Trying to get them to delay until mid July. DC Schools slow to respond to field requests for lacrosse.

CONTINUING BUSINESS

Committee Reports:

- Baseball – A/AA 22 teams so far. Registration open for another 4 weeks. AAA/Majors, C Prep – 24 teams so far, probably add another 2-3. Numbers are way down. Partially due to teams moving to Elite Division.

Much discussion on how many pre-season tournaments would be allowed, and how many fields are we willing to sub lease for these tournaments before games start.

Motion () – Assign preseason tournament committee, who's job would be to decide which teams can use our fields, and the dates they are allowed to use them. Tournament committee would be made up of Ken Thomas, Shaun Bristow, and Woody Gruenler.

Second (). Motion carries 10 – 0.

- Volleyball – On track for number of players and gym space.
- Lacrosse – Registration numbers are down, fields tough to get. Hoping for late rush on registrations, which happened last year.
- Football – Looking at an Elite league for football. Top nine teams per age group would qualify.
- Softball – no report.
- Fall Baseball – made money, field costs were primary reason.
- Basketball – Going well. Reimbursement from AYL should cover current deficit. Coach Matthew Hartwig walked out on his team during season. Not to coach any other Hawks sport.
- CCC – Ed McCaffrey – Spartan coach filed complaint. McCaffrey has responded. CCC in middle of dealing with issue. Sunny Coleman – bad background check. Not allowed to coach. Chris Sorensen – Used illegal player during fall baseball (underage) removed himself and his kid from team.

Motion (Martelon) – Chris Sorensen placed on one year probation, but be allowed to coach again, and has to work the Parker State Tune-Up as a volunteer. Second (Hatcher). Motion passes 10-0.

Scott Boyd – Motion (Woody) to reinstate Coach Boyd. Second (Ken Thomas). After much discussion, motion was tabled until February.

NEW BUSINESS:

Scholarship Policy – Sport coordinators will each decide who receives scholarships and how many.

Website Update / Review – new website is up and running. Looks good. Sports coordinator need to provide Hatcher with content.
