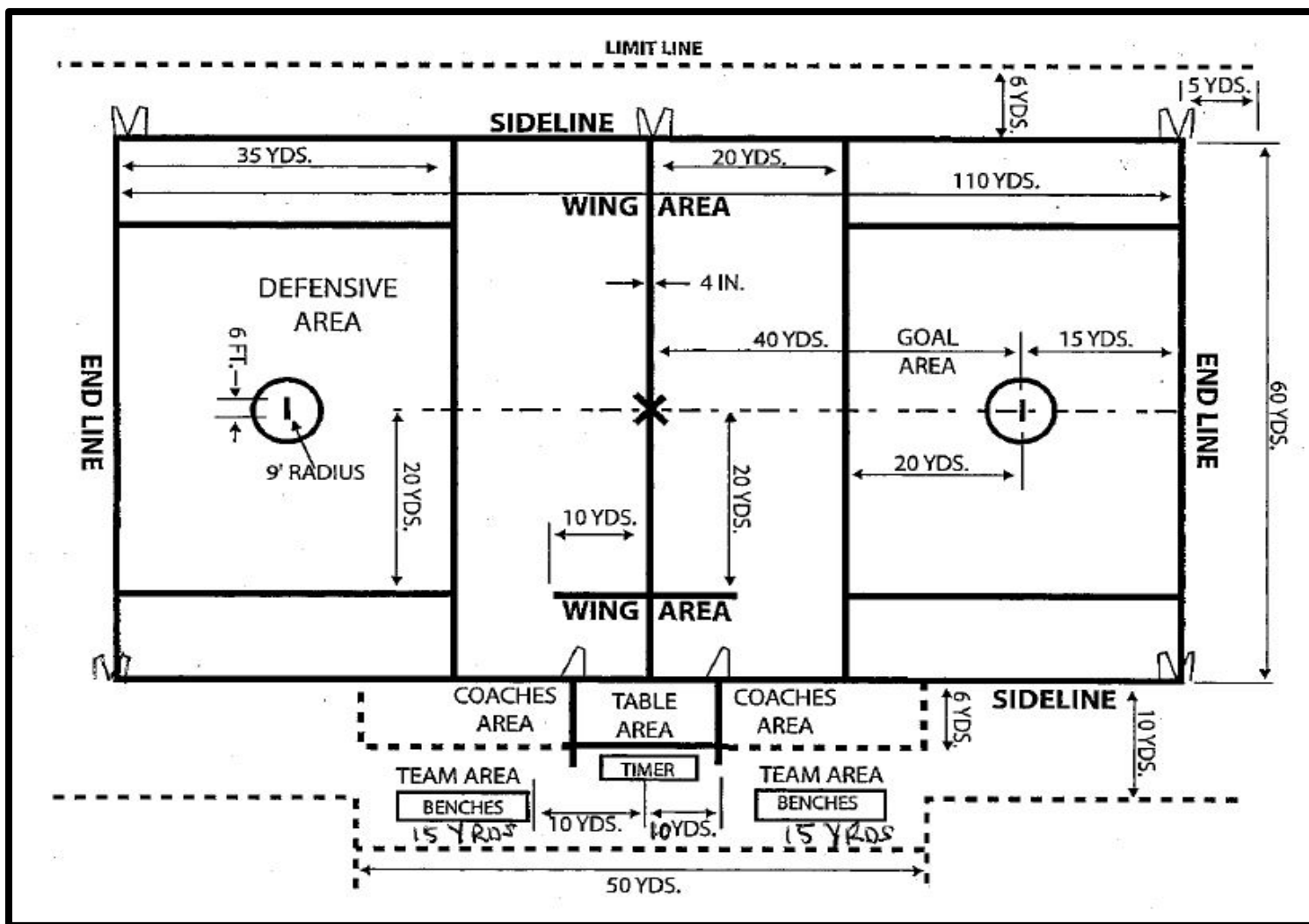

Home Team Procedures

- Make sure fields are properly lined.
- Spectators must be 6 yards away from sideline.
- Place 7 cones; one on each corner, 2 center lines, 2 10 yards from center for coaches area.
- Place 4 NOCSAE balls on each end line and 5 down each sideline, along with min 4 back up balls at table.
- Bring Table and 2 chairs –set up 6 yards from sideline at center of player side.
- 20 yards for table area; 10 yards in each direction from center line.
- Score clock and stopwatches for penalties & game horn.
- Backup batteries & horn
- Score sheet and pencils
- Score Flip Chart faced at the spectator side.
- No Duplicate numbers 0-99 only. Must be on both sides of uniform. Home teams wears #d pennies if visitor is not opposite color.
- Bring First Aid kit and Ice and know the address for closest emergency facility.
- Drinking water for you, coaches, and officials.
- Table is NEUTRAL ZONE – no comments or cheering.
- D3 games 4-12min running clock
- D1 & D2 games 4 10 min stop clock.
- Statisticians work from Spectator sideline!
- Culture Keeper on spectator sideline – must meet officials before game.
- If questions –ask the Officials!

Middle School Game Day Procedures Host Club:

1. Pre-fill out the score sheet with your player's names and jersey numbers, in numerical order.
2. Print Photo Roster found on www.snla.us for both teams and bring to game.
3. Fill out opponents players that are present on Visitor side of score sheet in numerical order.
4. 15 minutes before game starts, ask officials to line players up and check photo rosters to player on opposing team. Opposing team does the same for your players.
5. Keep track of all Goals/Assists by making a tick mark in the column next to player name.
6. Fouls are to be written in order of occurrence; Players Number, then what type of foul and the time it occurred.
7. All Coaches must wear their coaching card, no one else allowed on player sideline.
8. Make notes of late or missing officials and Ejections for either team. Fax or email complete and signed sheet to teams.
