Practice	1 Hour weeknight practice / week	3 or 4 practices, 1.5 hours each / week
Games	1 Saturday game vs a local community team, league play	Weekend tournaments, at least 3 games each, usually Saturday/Sunday, no league play
Season End	League tournament weekend, seeded by season record	State tournament, seeded by participating coaches and organizers
