Reduce Your Fees for Legion Baseball This Summer!

Diamond Baseball of Boulder, Inc (DBoB) is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to delivering quality baseball programs for its players and their families.

The regular expenses that DBoB incurs each summer include: Field maintenance and improvements, coaching fees, umpire fees, team uniforms, insurance, baseballs, equipment purchases, lights for night games, tournament fees, travel and lodging costs, administration fees, and financial aid for qualified families. These items increase in cost each year, and DBoB must raise the funds to cover these expenses in addition to other unplanned financial demands.

DBoB has two primary sources of revenue: Player fees, and personal or corporate partnerships. These partnerships can be designated to apply to either (a) the general DBoB fundraising fund or (b) reduce a specific player's fees. If the full partnership is designated towards the general fundraising fund, up to 100% of the sponsorship may be considered a tax-deductible donation.

If the partnership is designated to reduce a specific player's fees, 50% of the value of the partnership will be applied towards the chosen player's fees. In this case, up to 50% of the amount may be considered a tax-deductible donation. You may solicit multiple partnerships up to, but not exceeding, the full amount of your fees for the current year or remaining balances from the previous year. Consult your tax advisor for details.
