GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Haggai 2:1-5

The people were discouraged because the completed temple was not as grand as the former temple Solomon built. What does God draw their attention to?

Their discouragement came from comparing the new with the old rather than their obedience with God's instruction. When have you fallen into discouragement because your focus shifted away from God's instruction?

Discouragement often follows obedience. When have you seen this to be true in your own life?

Read Haggai 2:6-10

In verses 6-7 God declares that He is going to give them what all the nations desire. What is He referring to?

God tells the people that the size or appearance of the structure or container does not matter as much as what fills it. What does this mean for you in your fight against discouragement?

Read Philippians 4:4-7

The call to rejoice and the promise of peace are the result of the Lord being at hand. What steps can you take to position yourself closer to Jesus and to have a better perspective of your situation.

MEMORY VERSE
