## **GROUP QUESTIONS**

## Read John 20:19-21

- Why do you think Jesus says 'peace be with you'?
- Put yourself in the disciples shoes for a moment and imagine your reaction to losing someone close to you and then discovering they're back. What would that reaction look like?

## Read John 20:26-29

- What is Thomas' reaction to seeing Jesus' scars? Why is this significant?
- How has Jesus revealed this truth to you?
- Jesus used His scars as a testimony of His resurrection and power of death. How could you use your own emotional and spiritual scars to bring hope and healing to others?

## Read Matthew 28:16-20

 Jesus gives a final mission to his disciples, to reach the lost and make disciples. What practical steps could you take to be on this mission in light of what Jesus accomplished through His resurrection?
