GROUP QUESTIONS

Read Jeremiah 29:4-14

- What is the context of this message from God, according to verse 4? Why is this important?
- What are the four things that God tells the people of God to do while in their exile? Which one stands out to you the most?

Read Psalm 91:1-4 & Matthew 7:24-27

- What does it look like to build a home in God?
- Matthew 7:24-27 provides a measuring stick on how well your house can withstand a storm. Using this gauge do you think you have built your home in Him?

Read Romans 12:2 & Hebrews 11:1

- Why do you think there is such a correlation between truth and faith?
- Have you ever had a time where your faith was misplaced in something that wasn't true? What happened?
- In this day and age, with so much information and so little assurance of truth, what are the core, central truths we need to know and focus on?

Read 2 Corinthians 5:20 & 2 Corinthians 1:3-7

- How does having this mission change your perspective on your current and past circumstances?
- What mark could you leave on yourself and those around you during this season of life?
- What steps could you take to be more intentional about being on mission?
