Information Management

Health information professionals curate and make accessible, bioscience, clinical, and health information data, information, and knowledge.



Instruction & Instructional Design

Health information professionals educate others in the skills of bioscience, clinical, and health information literacy.



Library Leadership & Management

Health information professionals manage personnel, time, budget, facilities, and technology and lead staff to define and meet institutional goals.



Evidence-Based Practice & Research

Health information professionals evaluate research studies, use research to improve practice, conduct research, and communicate research results.



Health Information Professionalism

Health information professionals promote the development of their professions and collaborate with other professionals to improve health care and access to health care information for all.
