



## **Update on FMCSA Emergency Declaration**

Late last week the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) extended their emergency declaration (which NAW has previously reported on) through May 15<sup>th</sup>.

In conjunction with the extension of the emergency declaration, FMCSA released a new FAQ (frequently asked questions) to address many of the questions the agency has received specifically regarding actions State Drivers Licensing Agencies or commercial driver's license holders may take during the current COVID-19 emergency.
