

Professional Activity Credits (PAC)

What's a PAC?

A PAC, or Professional Activity Credit, is a type of continuing education which is awarded for participation in a variety of professional activities determined by ABGC to promote educational development and the genetic counseling profession. These activities include but are not limited to:

- Clinical Supervision
- Volunteer Leadership for a genetics organization
- Presenting at a conference
- Teaching
- Authorship

How do I claim PACs?

NSGC does not approve or issue PACs of any kind. All PAC claims and approvals must be handled through [ABGC](#). For all PAC questions contact ABGC at info@abgc.net.

You'll need to document your completed hours for the appropriate activity and enter them in your ABGC CEU Tracker. You may be asked to provide documentation or a certificate to confirm your completed hours.

Use [this grid](#) to document your hours, then submit it to the NSGC Staff Liaison for the committee/subcommittee/task force for which you are seeking PACs to obtain a confirmation signature. The signed form will serve as your confirmed documentation in the event you are audited for this PAC claim.

Please note, **to claim PACs for NSGC volunteer work, you must be in a leadership position.** This includes any appointed or elected chair, vice chair or group leader position in an NSGC committee, subcommittee, task force or advisory group.
