Her collections are certified: "Made in New York" through the New York Economic Development Corporation. Her "Key to the City" necklace, and "Liberty" pin designs were commissioned by New York City Store, located in Downtown Manhattan at City Hall.

In June, 2019, Michele Benjamin served as "Arts Envoy" on behalf of U.S. State Department, teaching jewelry, art, and women's entrepreneurship skills to promote Women's Empowerment in Cambodia, and to spread awareness on Animal Conservation in Laos.

Her collections are offered in art galleries, cultural institutions, and boutiques in the U.S., and online nationally and internationally, including her iconic Bee design, which is also offered at the "Whitney Museum of American Art" Shop online, and on Amazon.com.

Michele Benjamin's love of fine art and the natural environment inspire the concept and creation of her artistic life forms, including bees, butterflies, angelfish, hummingbirds, tortoises, dragonflies, starfish, seahorses, and more.
