KEENAN CEMETERY

CAPE GIRARDEAU CO. CEMETERY # 207

Keenan Cemetery is located 2600 ft southeast of County Road 651. The cemetery is 35 ft x 25 ft, in fair condition, and has no enclosure. There are 20 burials with 11 inscribed stones. It is south of Little Flora Creek and 1000 ft east of the railroad tracks. From the railroad trestle over Little Flora Creek, walk southwest for about 1/2 mile, where a hill comes close to the tracks. Take the old road up the hill for about 500 ft, and the cemetery is to the left (west) along the edge of the hill. Vinca has been planted in the cemetery. All but one of the marked graves (#11) are covered by concrete slabs poured over the entire grave. Special thanks to Mr. Kenneth Foeste for guiding us to the cemetery. 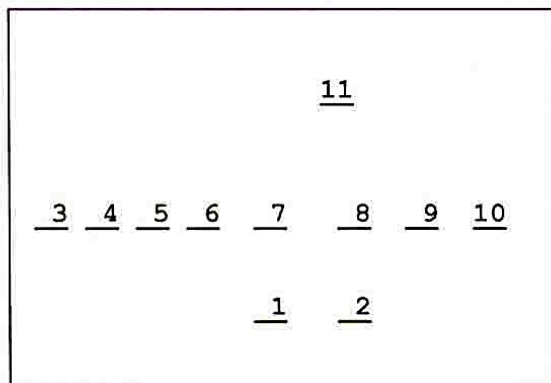
