Cloud Nine Nuptials

February 14, 2019

Location: Mt. Snow, W. Dover, VT

Celebrate Valentine's Day at Mount Snow in the most romantic way possible: renew your vows or get married on the mountain at the top of Cloud Nine on Thursday, February 14.

We will start the morning with a lift ride up the Sunbrook Quad at 9:45 am. We recommend loading the Bluebird Express lift no later than 9:20 am for a ride to the summit, and then skiing down "Thanks Walt" to the bottom of Sunbrook.

If you are running a few minutes late, don't worry! Just head up the Bluebird Express and go directly to the top of the Sunbrook Quad/top of "Cloud Nine" ski trail and meet us there. The ceremony will begin as promptly as possible at 10:15 am.

Please understand that we will have a good number of couples involved and while we hope for a beautiful bluebird day, Mother Nature is not necessarily on our side - for this reason we cannot delay the ceremony, so please plan accordingly and give yourselves plenty of time in the morning. You can always take an extra run if early!

We'll conclude by taking a run down "Cloud Nine" and then meet us back up top inside the Summit Lodge at The Bullwheel for cake & coffee.

If you would like to get married legally, you will just need to provide the Justice of the Peace with the proper paperwork for her to sign and make the matrimony official. www.mountsnow.com
