

Get to Know Severna Park, Maryland

Severna Park rests in Anne Arundel county, and is part of the Baltimore-Washington Metropolitan Area.



A Taste of History

Severna Park was originally named "Boone." A stop along the Baltimore & Annapolis Railroad, which was converted to the B&A Rail Trail in 1990. Severna Park sits between the eastern shore of the Severn River and northwestern shore of the Magothy River. A large percentage of the Baltimore & Annapolis Trail runs through Severna Park. The B & A Trail, which is now a bike trail, was originally a rail trail before being converted as part of the East Coast Greenway in 1996.
