

10 BEST VEGETABLES TO GROW IN CONTAINERS

TYPE OF VEGGIE	USDA GROW ZONE	SUN	SOIL
ARUGULA ————————————————————————————————————	3 to 11	Full sun to partial shade	Good drainage, moist soil
CUCUMBERS Plastic/ceramic pot to keep moist	4 to 12	Full sun to partial shade	Good drainage and moist, fertilized soil
EGGPLANT Need compact varieties, large pot	5 to 12	Full sun	Good drainage, moist soil
HOT & SWEET PEPPERS Big containers, ample drainage/sun	Grown as annual in all zones	Full sun	Good drainage, moist soil
LETTUCE & SALAD GREENS Pot with drainage, don't overwater	4 to 9	Partial sun	Moist, fertilized soil
PEAS Plant in early spring/fall, use stakes	2 to 11	Full sun	Good drainage, enriched or loamy soil
POTATOES Add a lot of soil, water frequently	3 to 10B	Full sun	Good drainage, enriched or loamy soil
RADISHES Plant in 4" to 6" deep containers	2 to 10	Full sun to partial shade	Good drainage, moist soil
SQUASH Large container, water consistently	3 to 10	Full sun	Rich soil, good drainage
TOMATOES Large containers, use stakes or cage	Grown as annual in all zones	Full sun	Deep, moist, good drainage
