RE Existing Wastewater Capacity in the Town of Brandon

The Town of Brandon operates a wastewater collection and treatment system with sufficient unobligated capacity to accommodate an additional 36 three-bedroom homes at current design flows as set forth in Subchapter 8 of the Environmental Protection Rules for Wastewater Systems and Potable Water Supply, as published by the State of Vermont, Agency of Natural Resources, Department of Environmental Conservation, Drinking Water and Groundwater Protection Division.

This letter does not speak to the availability of connection to the wastewater system at any given site, nor does it speak to the capacity of the drinking water which is provided by Brandon Fire District No. 1, not the Town of Brandon.
