Zimbra can be deployed in the cloud, on-premises (private cloud), or as a hybrid service. Deployment on-prem or via an in-country Zimbra Partner guarantees data sovereignty.

Lowest Total Cost of Ownership (TCO) = Big Savings

Zimbra's lower TCO is an important factor for governments. Zimbra's licensing options combined with Zimbra Open Source Edition (OSE) result in big savings.

- The Vatican **migrated users from Microsoft and Oracle onto Zimbra** to reduce costs in licensing and support. 
- AFIP (Argentinian taxation authority) uses Zimbra Network Edition (NE) for employees and Zimbra OSE for Argentinian businesses that cannot afford their own email infrastructure. This provides faster, streamlined services for AFIP and their customers. 
- Malaysia's Ministry of Home Affairs has 9,100 employees - 1500 use Zimbra NE and 7600 use Zimbra Standard Edition. 
- Brazil's Ministry of Culture **moved from Microsoft to Zimbra for lower TCO.** 

Zimbra is also compatible with Microsoft Outlook on Windows and Mac. If you have users who require Outlook, you can accommodate them and use Zimbra for everyone else.
