

# STEWART CREEK HIGH SCHOOL

## School Performance Grade and Accountability

Stewart Creek High School opened in 2015-16. Although it was operating as an alternative school and sought to be graded as such, it received a grade of “F” in that year because it had not yet been officially classified by the State as an alternative school.

For 2016-17 and later years, Stewart Creek was approved as an “Alternative School” by the North Carolina State Board of Education (NC-SBE) for purposes of participation in the North Carolina Alternative Schools’ Alternative Accountability Model (ASAM).

Before each school year the NC-SBE approves Stewart Creek’s Alternative Accountability targets.

At the conclusion of each school year, Stewart Creek has been evaluated on the approved measures. Following are Stewart Creek’s accountability ratings for each year since being designated as an alternative school by the North Carolina State Board of Education:
