Packing

WHAT TO BRING

Bible
Notebook and pen/pencil
Clothing for five days
Personal toiletry items
Prescription medication
Towel
Bedding (sheets, blankets, pillows)/sleeping bag to fit a twin bed
Money for travel, the MOVE Store, offering, etc. (optional)
Athletic attire for recreation time (optional)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, vapes, etc.
Refrigerators, TV's, fireworks, or air-conditioner

MOVE CLOTHING GUIDELINES

UNACCEPTABLE

Short Shorts
Sagging Pants
Bikinis
Miniskirts
Spaghetti straps
Low-cut tops
Morph suits
Non-medical masks

To help with the length issue for the shorts/skirts/dresses, please abide by this guideline: With your arms hanging naturally by your side, your shorts/skirts/dresses must be longer than your fingertips. No spaghetti straps, halters, or strapless tops/dresses. You can wear those items if you wear a sweater/jacket over them. Ladies, if you have a question about this, please ask a female adult leader.

MEDICATION

While we do not anticipate any injuries, minor injuries can sometimes occur. Our designated adult leader will be able to assist in providing the appropriate care for any minor injury or mild sickness that may arise.

Our adult leader will also be handling any and all prescription medications, other than such things as an EpiPen or inhaler that a child would normally keep with them. If your child has any prescription medication that needs to be administered during the event or over-the-counter medication that a parent prefers the adult leader to administer, please bring those medications to check-in with only the necessary dosing required for the duration of the event. Please clearly label the packaging so that it includes your child's full name and dosing instructions. Our adult leader will then assist your child to ensure dosing instructions are followed.

MOVE PACKING INSTRUCTIONS

Because of the number of students, these are the packing guidelines that will enable us to organize our luggage and ensure a prompt loading/unloading process. Please follow them carefully and thank you in advance for your cooperation. Students are permitted to bring three luggage items.

- 1 Medium Suitcase or Bag with your name clearly marked on the outside
- 1 Bedding Bag for your pillow, sleeping bag/blanket, sheets (twin size)
 - *This should be a large, plastic garbage bag with your name on the side in large, clear lettering written on a piece of duct tape.*
 - *Include an extra plastic bag for the return trip.*
- 1 Backpack

Cell Phones

To limit distractions so students can fully connect with God and their peers we are strongly encouraging students to leave their phones at home for the week. If a student brings their phone, they will be collected at registration at Connection Pointe and placed in a secure location by CP Staff. Phones will be returned upon heading back to the church on July 15.

MOVE Rules

- Respect others and yourself.
- No guys in girls' dorms beyond the front lobby and vice versa.
- Alcohol, tobacco, vaping, drugs, and weapons are absolutely prohibited.
- Everyone must be in his or her dorm by the designated "In Dorm Time."
- For security reasons, no students with backpacks are allowed into the auditorium or cafeteria.
- Follow the schedule. Be where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there.
- During sessions, stay in your church's assigned seating area. Please follow the posted seating chart.
- Do not leave the auditorium once the speakers begin talking.
- Respect the campus – no TP, water balloons, shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, etc. No practical jokes.
- Do not move furniture. You will be charged for venue staff moving it back.
- Do not dial 911 unless it is a true emergency.
- Absolutely no fireworks at any time during MOVE or while on campus property.
- No deliveries of any kind to the campus.
- Students may leave campus **ONLY** with adult supervision; those staying behind must have an adult present.
- Follow the MOVE dress code.
- No hazing of any kind will be tolerated.
