

Read: Hebrews 11:1 NIrV





You know it's there

Have you ever been outside on a really windy day? Maybe you've even flown a kite when it's windy.

Your hair blows, or you see trees swaying and leaves blowing around. But can you see the wind? No, you can't. You can only see what the wind does.

Faith in Jesus is a lot like that. We can't see Him, but we can see the things Jesus does and the things He has done. We can see the ways Jesus loves us, and the ways He helps people.

LOOK for ways you see people trusting in Jesus, or ways Jesus helps people.



Hebrews 11:1 NIrV

Practice learning the main memory verse for the month.

Faith is being sure (thumbs up) of what we hope for (hands in prayer), and certain of what we do not see (cover eyes). Hebrews 11:1

KNOW that you can have faith in God even if you don't see Him with your eyes.



Have Faith

Make a path in your living room with different pillows on the floor. Have someone close their eyes, and then you lead them or tell them where to step. Sometimes, we have to trust God to tell us where to go or what to do, just like you told someone where to go when they couldn't see.

ASK God to lead you every day.

God always knows what is best and has the best plan for you. Trust Him today. Abraham didn't know how everything would turn out, but God led Him, and Abraham followed and obeyed God.


THANK God that He has a plan.

So many things change, but God doesn't change! He stays the same. Can you tell God how much you are thankful for Him!


"Dear God, thank You so much that You stay the same. I'm so glad You stay the same and I can trust You. I love You, God. Amen."

Wait with God

Have you ever felt like something hard or sad would always be that way? Will you will always miss your friend who had to move? Will you will always feel bad about striking out at the baseball game last week?

Some things hurt really bad for a short time and then they get better. Some things take more time. Some things will always hurt.

But however long it takes, God is still with you. He is still taking care of you. God will always be with you.

ASK God to help you wait with Him when times get tough.
