SAY THIS

Who loves you?
God loves me.

WHAT YOU NEED:

Various musical instruments
(pots, pans, and wooden
spoons work)

WHAT YOU DO:

Pass out the instruments and have everyone line up behind you. Wave your arms back and forth like a conductor as you lead everyone in a march around the room. Lower your arms as a signal for the children to stop playing and marching. Say God loves me and then march again!

WHAT YOU SAY:

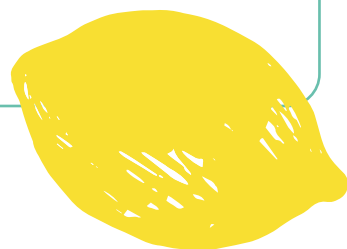
