Get a blank sheet of paper and some markers. Okay, ready? Draw a picture of God. **And . . . go!**

Let's try this instead. Draw a picture of something God created.

What did you draw? A person? An animal? A plant? Something else in nature? Any of these would work, because God made it all!

Seeing God in Creation • Romans 1:20 **Bottom Line:** FOCUS on what you can see.

When you look at this creation, what do you notice? Take a closer look. Underneath your drawing, write down at least three characteristics of that creation that you believe teach you something about God, like His creativity or attention to detail.

Isn't it cool that even though we can't see God, we can see Him at work, and that helps us get to know Him? This isn't a new idea, though. Paul even writes about this in Romans 1:20, saying it's possible to "see the qualities of God that are not seen" through "what he has made" (NIrV). As you go throughout your day today, FOCUS on the things that God has made—the things we can see—and think about what that teaches you about Him!
