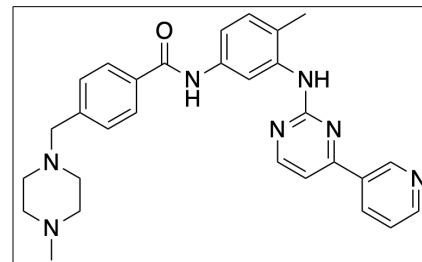

Description Imatinib is an anticancer chemotherapeutic compound that inhibits Abl, c-Kit, and PDGFR; it is used clinically to treat Philadelphia chromosome-positive chronic myelogenous leukemia (CML) and acute lymphocytic leukemia (ALL). In cellular assays, imatinib accelerates erythroblast differentiation and inhibits melanogenesis.
