| 1 | (d) Training and Protocol Requirements. – Each K-12 school unit shall provide its |
| 2 | adopted mental health training program program, suicide prevention education, and suicide risk |
| 3 | referral protocol to school personnel at no cost to the employee. Employees shall receive an initial |
| 4 | mental health training of at least six hours and subsequent mental health trainings of at least two |
| 5 | hours. The initial mental health training shall occur within the first six months of employment. |
| 6 | Subsequent mental health trainings shall occur in the following school year and annually thereafter. Additionally, school percentage shall complete one hour of quiside provention |
| 7 8 | thereafter. Additionally, school personnel shall complete one hour of suicide prevention education each year to coincide with subsequent mental health trainings. In the discretion of the |
| o 9 | K-12 school unit, the initial mental health training may be waived in the event the employee |

| 36 | (f) Reporting; State Audit. – By September 15 of each year, each K-12 school unit shall |
