6	SECT	ION 1.(a) The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health	
7	Benefits (DHB), s	shall develop and, to the extent allowed under G.S. 108A-54.1A, implement a	
8	plan for a statewic	le reimbursement methodology for behavioral health services provided to adult	
9	Medicaid beneficiaries with severe and persistent mental illness who are served by a clubhouse		
10	model psychosocial rehabilitation day program. The plan shall include all of the following:		
11	(1)	Incentives for clubhouses to become accredited by Clubhouse International.	
12	(2)	Consistent application of rates throughout regions served by local	
13		management entities/managed care organizations (LME/MCOs).	
14	(3)	Education and training for LME/MCO staff and relevant staff within the	
15		Department of Health and Human Services on the clubhouse model and its	
16		use in serving individuals with severe and persistent mental illness in this	
17		State.	
18	SECT	ION 1.(b) No later than December 1, 2025, DHB shall submit a report to the	
19	U U	Oversight Committee on Medicaid that contains all of the following information	
20	related to the plan required by subsection (a) of this section:		
21	(1)	The proposed reimbursement methodology.	
22	(2)	A proposed time line for implementation for the reimbursement methodology.	
23	(3)	Any costs associated with implementation of the reimbursement	
24		methodology.	
25	(4)	Details on the education and training developed for LME/MCOs and staff of	
26		the Department of Health and Human Services.	
27		ION 2. Effective July 1, 2025, there is appropriated from the General Fund to	
28		a Clubhouse Coalition, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two million	
29	five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) in recurring funds for each year of the 2025-2027		
30	fiscal biennium to be used to provide funding for member clubhouses for current programs,		
31	expansion of services or locations served, accreditation of a clubhouse, or staff training and		
32	professional development.		
33	SECT	ION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
