- 2 "PRIOR APPROVAL BY THE STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES, TO MAKE
- 3 CHANGES TO THE STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND LOCAL
- 4 BOARDS OF TRUSTEES, AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAMPUS SAFETY."; 5
- 6 on page 3, line 43, through page 6, line 5, by rewriting those lines to read:
- 7 8 "SECTION 4. G.S. 115D-2.2 reads as rewritten: 9 "§ 115D-2.2. State Board of Community Colleges. The State Board of Community Colleges is established. 10 (a) 11 (b) The State Board of Community Colleges shall consist of 22-19 members, as follows: The Lieutenant Governor or the Lieutenant Governor's designee shall be a 12 (1)13 member ex officio. 14 The Treasurer of North Carolina or the Treasurer's designee shall be a member (2)15 ex officio. The Commissioner of Labor or the Commissioner's designee shall be a 16 (3)member ex officio. 17 18 (4) The Governor shall appoint to the State Board four members from the State at large and one member from each of the six Trustee Association Regions 19 20 defined in G.S. 115D-62. Each appointment by the Governor shall be for a term of four years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. Any 21 vacancy occurring among the Governor's appointees before the expiration of 22 23 term shall be filled by appointment of the Governor. The member appointed 24 to fill a vacancy shall meet the same residential qualification, if any, as the 25 vacating member and shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term of that member. 26 27 (5) The General Assembly shall elect eight members of the State Board from the State at large to a term of four years and until a successor is elected and 28 29 qualifies. The Senate shall elect four members and the House of Representatives shall elect four members in accordance with subsection (c) of 30 this section. Members elected by either chamber of the General Assembly, 31





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1			shall to the degree practicable, be proportional to the party representation of	
2			the respective chamber.	
3		(6)	The person serving as president of the North Carolina Comprehensive	
4			Community College Student Government Association shall be an ex officio	
5			member of the State Board. If the president of the Association is unable for	
6			any reason to serve as the student member of the State Board, then pursuant	
7			to the constitution of the Association, the vice-president of the Association	
8			shall serve as the student member of the State Board. Any person serving as	
9			the student member of the State Board must be a student in good standing at	
10			a North Carolina community college. The student member of the State Board	
11			shall have all the rights and privileges of membership, except that the student	
12			member shall not have a vote.

14	(g)	The f	ollowing people shall be prohibited from serving as a member of the State Board:	
15		(1)	A member of the General Assembly currently serving or who has served	
16		<u> </u>	within the prior three years or that member's spouse.	
17		(2)	An officer or employee of the State or that person's spouse.	
18		(3)	An officer or employee of an institution under the jurisdiction of the State	
19		<u></u>	Board or that person's spouse.	
20		(4)	A person who within five years has been an employee of the Community	
21			Colleges System Office or that person's spouse.	
22		<u>(5)</u>	A member of the Council of State currently serving or who has served within	
23		<u></u>	the prior three years.	
24		<u>(6)</u>	A lobbyist registered with the Secretary of State currently or within the prior	
25		<u> </u>	three years or that person's spouse.	
26		<u>(7)</u>	An individual who made a campaign donation to the campaign committee of	
27			any individual running for statewide office within the prior three years.	
28		<u>(8)</u>	An individual convicted of a sex offense under Article 7B of Chapter 14 of	
29			the General Statutes, regardless of whether or not the conviction was	
30			expunged.	
31		<u>(9)</u>	An individual required to register as a sex offender under Article 27A of	
32			Chapter 14 of the General Statutes.

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Colleges shall also meet with the State Board of Education and the Board of Governors of The 1 2 University of North Carolina at least once a year to discuss educational matters of mutual interest 3 and to recommend to the General Assembly such policies as are appropriate to encourage the 4 improvement of public education at every level in this State; these joint meetings shall be hosted 5 by the three Boards according to the schedule set out in G.S. 115C-11(b1). Special meetings of 6 the State Board may be set at any regular meeting or may be called by the chair. A majority of the qualified members of the State Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. 7 8"; 9 10 and on page 8, lines 19-20, by rewriting the lines to read: 11 12 **"PART VI. CAMPUS SAFETY FUNDS** 13 **SECTION 6.** There is appropriated ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) from the 14 General Fund to the State Board of Community Colleges to be allocated by the State Board to 15 the community colleges to study and address campus safety issues. 16 17 PART VII. EFFECTIVE DATE 18 **SECTION 7.** Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes 19 law.".
