AN ACT defining "wake boat."

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Paragraph; Boating and Water Safety; Definition; Wake Boat. Amend RSA 270-D:1 by
 2 inserting after paragraph XII the following new paragraph:
 3 XII-a. "Wake boat" means any boat that is equipped with ballast tanks, bags, compartments,
 4 containers, plumbing, or similar devices or systems that are designed to alter or enhance the
 5 characteristics of the boat's wake, and is also known as a "ballast boat."
- 6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
