SENATE BILL

An act to amend Section 26835 of the Penal Code, relating to firearms.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 417, as amended, Blakespear. Firearms: licensed dealers.

Existing law requires any sale or transfer of a firearm to be processed through a licensed dealer. Existing law requires each dealer to conspicuously post certain warnings and notices within their licensed premises, including safe storage requirements, requirements regarding the reporting of lost and stolen firearms, and information regarding the suicide prevention lifeline.

This bill would revise this required posting, as specified.

- 10 SUBSTANCE KNOWN TO CAUSE BIRTH DEFECTS,
- 11 REPRODUCTIVE HARM, AND OTHER SERIOUS PHYSICAL
- 12 INJURY. HAVE ADEQUATE VENTILATION AT ALL TIMES.

- 14 (7) "FEDERAL REGULATIONS PROVIDE THAT IF YOU

- 10 (2) The statement in paragraph (1) shall be posted on the counter of one of the main gun displays or within five feet of the
- 12 cash register. The statement shall not be placed on the floor or
- 13 the ceiling of the premises.
- 14 (c) This section shall become operative on January 1, 2024.
