BY:

- 1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 6 on third reading as follows:
- 2 (1) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the
- 3 bill and renumber the remaining SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
- 4 SECTION . Section 37.002, Education Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsection (b-2) to read as follows:
- 6 (b-2) After removal of a student from the classroom under
- 7 Section 37.002, on the student's return to the classroom the
- 8 teacher shall:
- 9 (1) employ appropriate classroom management techniques
- 10 that can reasonably be expected to improve the student's behavior;
- 11 and
- 12 (2) document the student's behavior the teacher
- 13 determines either:
- 14 (A) repeatedly interferes with the teacher's
- 15 ability to communicate effectively with the students in the class
- 16 or with the ability of the student's classmates to learn; or
- 17 (B) is so unruly, disruptive, or abusive it
- 18 seriously interferes with the teacher's ability to communicate
- 19 effectively with the students in the class or with the ability of
- 20 the student's classmates to learn.
- 21 (2) In SECTION 1 of the bill, in amended Section
- 22 12.111(a)(5), Education Code, strike "discipline history,".
- 23 (3) In SECTION 1 of the bill, in amended Section
- 24 12.111(a)(5)(A), Education Code, strike "is currently".
- 25 (4) In SECTION 1 of the bill, strike amended Sections

- 1 12.111(a)(5)(A)(i) and (ii) and substitute the following:
- 2 <u>(i) has engaged in conduct outlined in</u>
- 3 <u>Section 37.006 related to placement in a disciplinary alternative</u>
- 4 education program or a juvenile justice alternative education
- 5 program;
- 6 (ii) has engaged in conduct outlined in
- 7 Section 37.007 related to expulsion; or
- 8 (iii) has been convicted of a criminal offense or has a
- 9 juvenile court adjudication [has a documented history of a criminal
- 10 offense, a juvenile court adjudication, or discipline problems
- 11 under Subchapter A, Chapter 37]; and
- 12 (5) In the SECTION of the bill amending Section 37.005,
- 13 Education Code, strike added Subsection (c-1).
- 14 (6) In the SECTION of the bill adding Section 37.0083,
- 15 Education Code, add the following:
- 16 <u>(a-1)</u> If the board of trustees of a school district, the
- board's designee, or a juvenile court places a student in a virtual
- 18 disciplinary alternative education program under this section, the
- 19 school district shall ensure that the student has suitable home
- 20 computer equipment and Internet access and provide the computer
- 21 equipment and Internet access if necessary.
- 22 (7) In the SECTION of the bill adding Section 37.1151,
- 23 Education Code, insert the following appropriately lettered
- 24 subsection and reletter the remaining subsections accordingly:
- 25 <u>() Before the expiration of an order issued under</u>
- 26 Subsection (d) for a student enrolled in the school district's
- 27 special education program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, the

- 1 school district shall seek consent from the student's parent or
- 2 person standing in parental relation to conduct a functional
- 3 <u>behavioral assessment of the student by a licensed specialist in</u>
- 4 school psychology, a licensed behavior analyst, or a behavior
- 5 <u>specialist.</u>
