6	TO BE ENTITLED
7	AN ACT
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9	Relating to the acquisition of title to real property;
10	to amend Section 35-1-1, Code of Alabama 1975, to prohibit
11	Chinese citizens, the Chinese government, or Chinese entities
12	from acquiring real property in the state.
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as
15	the Alabama Property Protection Act.
16	Section 2. Section 35-1-1, Code of Alabama 1975, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	"\$35-1-1
19	AnExcept as provided in Section 3 of this act, an
20	alien, resident or nonresident may take and hold property,
21	real and personal, in this state, either by purchase, descent,
22	or devise, and may dispose of and transmit the same by sale,
23	descent, or devise as a native citizen."
24	Section 3. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the
25	following governments, entities or individuals shall not
26	purchase or otherwise acquire title to real property in this
27	state:
28	(1) Any governmental entity of China.



29 (2) Any company or other entity that is any of the30 following:

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a. Headquartered in China.

32 b. Directly or indirectly held or controlled by33 the government of China.

34 c. Of which the majority of its stock or other
 35 ownership interest is held or controlled by individuals who
 36 are citizens of China.

d. Of which the majority of stock or other ownership
interest of which is held or controlled by a company or entity
described by paragraphs a., b., or c.

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(3) Any individual who is a citizen of China.

(b) Subsection (a) shall apply only to the purchase of or other acquisition of title to real property on or after the effective date of this act. The purchase of or other acquisition of title to real property prior to the effective date of this act is governed by the law in effect immediately prior to the effective date of this act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

49 <u>provider shall be liable for any violation of Section 3(a).</u>
50 Section 5. <u>This act shall not be construed to apply to</u>

51 <u>any of the following:</u>

52 (a) A citizen, entity, or company of Taiwan.

53 (b) An existing business or the expansion of an

54 existing business on contiguous property.

55 Section 6. This act shall become effective on the first 56 day of the third month following its passage and approval by



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57 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
