4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 25.0344, Education Code, as added by Acts
6	2023, 88th Leg., R.S., Ch. 583 (H.B. 2892), Sec. 1, is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	Sec. 25.0344. TRANSFER OF STUDENTS WHO ARE CHILDREN OF
9	CERTAIN JUDGES, PEACE OFFICERS, PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS, AND
10	<u>SERVICEMEMBERS</u> . (a) In this section: $[\tau]$
11	(1) "peace officer" has the meaning assigned by Section
12	1701.001, Occupations Code.
13	(2) "prosecuting attorney" includes a county
14	prosecutor, state prosecutor, or state prosecuting attorney as
15	defined in Section 46.001, Government Code.
16	(3) "servicemember" means an active duty member of the
17	armed forces of the United States, a reserve component of the armed
18	forces of the United States, or the Texas National Guard.
19	(4) "judge" means the judge of the supreme court, court
20	of criminal appeals, appellate court, district court, or statutory
21	county court, as well as any associate judge of the same.
22	(b) On request of a judge, peace officer, prosecuting
23	attorney, or servicemember who is a parent of or person standing
24	in parental relation to a student, the board of trustees of a

school district or the board's designee shall transfer the student
 to another district campus or to another school district under an
 agreement under Section 25.035.

4 (c) A transfer under this section must be to the campus or 5 school district, as applicable, selected by the <u>judge</u>, peace 6 officer<u>, prosecuting attorney</u>, or <u>servicemember</u> making the 7 request.

8 (d) A school district is not required to provide 9 transportation to a student who transfers to another campus or 10 school district under this section.

SECTION 2. Section 25.0344, Education Code, as added by Acts
2023, 88th Leg., R.S., Ch. 583 (H.B. 2892), Sec. 1, is repealed.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
