Senator Rabon

1 moves to amend the bill on page 3, lines 5-6, by rewriting the lines to read:

2 Knowingly, or having reason to know, sell a hemp-derived consumable ''(1)product to a person who is under 21 years of age. Any seller of hemp-derived 3 consumable products shall demand proof of age from a prospective purchaser 4 5 of hemp-derived consumable products before the hemp-derived consumable products are released to the purchaser if the seller has reasonable grounds to 6 believe that the prospective purchaser is under 30 years of age. Any seller 7 that sells a hemp-derived consumable product on an internet website shall 8 verify the age of any perspective purchaser and shall use a method of delivery 9 that requires the signature of a person at least 21 years of age before the hemp-10 derived consumable product is released."; 11 12

13 and on page 3, lines 25-26, by inserting the following between the lines:

14"(8)Distribute hemp-derived consumable products through displays accessible to15the public without the assistance of a retailer's employee or agent other than16in an establishment open only to persons 21 years of age or older.".
