- 4 (2) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the
- 5 bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
- 6 SECTION . Section 22.011(b), Penal Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) A sexual assault under Subsection (a)(1) is without the
- 9 consent of the other person if consent, as defined by Section
- 10 1.07(a), is not present or if:
- 11 (1) the actor compels the other person to submit or
- 12 participate by the use of physical force, violence, or coercion;
- 13 (2) the actor compels the other person to submit or
- 14 participate by threatening to use force or violence against the
- 15 other person or to cause harm to the other person, and the other
- 16 person believes that the actor has the present ability to execute
- 17 the threat;
- 18 (3) the other person has not consented and the actor
- 19 knows the other person is unconscious or physically unable to
- 20 resist;
- 21 (4) the actor knows that as a result of mental disease
- 22 or defect the other person is at the time of the sexual assault
- 23 incapable either of appraising the nature of the act or of
- 24 resisting it;

- 1 (5) the other person has not consented and the actor
- 2 knows the other person is unaware that the sexual assault is
- 3 occurring;
- 4 (6) the actor has intentionally impaired the other
- 5 person's power to appraise or control the other person's conduct
- 6 by administering any substance without the other person's
- 7 knowledge;
- 8 (7) the actor compels the other person to submit or
- 9 participate by threatening to use force or violence against any
- 10 person, and the other person believes that the actor has the
- 11 ability to execute the threat;
- 12 (8) the actor is a public servant who coerces the other
- 13 person to submit or participate;
- 14 (9) the actor is a mental health services provider or
- 15 a health care services provider who causes the other person, who
- 16 is a patient or former patient of the actor, to submit or
- 17 participate by exploiting the other person's emotional dependency
- 18 on the actor;
- 19 (10) the actor is a clergyman who causes the other
- 20 person to submit or participate by exploiting the other person's
- 21 emotional dependency on the clergyman in the clergyman's
- 22 professional character as spiritual adviser;
- 23 (11) the actor is an employee of a facility where the
- 24 other person is a resident, unless the employee and resident are
- 25 formally or informally married to each other under Chapter 2,
- 26 Family Code;
- 27 (12) the actor is a health care services provider who,
- 28 in the course of performing an assisted reproduction procedure on
- 29 the other person, uses human reproductive material from a donor
- 30 knowing that the other person has not expressly consented to the
- 31 use of material from that donor;

- 1 (13) the actor is a coach or tutor who causes the other
- 2 person to submit or participate by using the actor's power or
- 3 influence to exploit the other person's dependency on the actor;
- 4 or
- 5 (14) the actor is a caregiver hired to assist the other
- 6 person with activities of daily life and causes the other person
- 7 to submit or participate by exploiting the other person's
- 8 dependency on the actor.
