An act relating to pupil transportation.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 88, as introduced, Skinner. Pupil transportation: school pupil activity bus: drivers.

Existing law requires the driver of a school pupil activity bus, as defined, to be subject to the regulations adopted by the Department of the California Highway Patrol governing schoolbus drivers, except as specified.

This bill would express the intent of the Legislature to enact subsequent legislation to codify existing regulations and rules that currently govern who can provide pupil transportation and what type of vehicle can be used for this purpose.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to enact
- 2 subsequent legislation that would codify existing regulations and
- 3 rules that currently govern who can provide pupil transportation
- 4 and what type of vehicle can be used for this purpose.
