5 SECTION 1. G.S. 15A-1344 is amer

SECTION 1. G.S. 15A-1344 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 "(b2) District Attorney May File Petition. – Based on the violation of a condition of 7 probation, the district attorney of the prosecutorial district as defined in G.S. 7A-60 in which 8 probation was imposed may file a petition to reduce, terminate, extend, modify, or revoke 9 probation in the district court district as defined in G.S. 7A-133 or superior court district or set 10 of districts as defined in G.S. 7A-41.1, as the case may be, where probation was imposed. Any 11 petition filed by a district attorney pursuant to this subsection shall be served on the probationer 12 by the supervising probation officer."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to petitions filed
 on or after that date.
