- 3 the composition of the governing bodies of local mental health

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 533.035, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 8 (f) A local mental health authority shall make available a
- 9 monthly expense report in an electronic format, detailing every
- 10 expenditure as reasonably practical by the local mental health
- 11 authority, to each member of the governing body, including ex
- 12 officio nonvoting members.
- 13 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 533.0351, Health and
- 14 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 533.0351. REQUIRED COMPOSITION AND GOVERNANCE OF LOCAL
- 16 MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITY GOVERNING BODY.
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 533.0351, Health and Safety Code, is
- 18 amended by amending Subsections (a), (b), (c), and (c-1) and adding
- 19 Subsections (a-1), (a-2), and (c-2) to read as follows:
- 20 (a) Each $[\frac{1f}{a}]$ local mental health authority $\underline{\text{must have}}$ $[\frac{has}{a}]$
- 21 a governing body.
- 22 $\underline{\text{(a-1)}}$ The [, the] governing body must include:
- 23 (1) for a local authority that serves only one county,
- 24 the sheriff of the county as an ex officio nonvoting member; and

- 1 (2) for a local authority that serves two or more
- 2 counties, two sheriffs chosen in accordance with Subsection (b) as
- 3 ex officio nonvoting members.
- 4 (a-2) At least one member of the governing board must be a
- 5 member of the public, have experience owning or operating a private
- 6 business, and not have served in elected office.
- 7 (b) In selecting sheriffs to serve as members under
- 8 Subsection (a-1)(2), a [A] local mental health authority that
- 9 serves two or more counties shall take the median population size
- 10 of each of those counties and choose:
- 11 (1) one sheriff of a county with a population above the
- 12 median population size to serve as an ex officio nonvoting member
- 13 under Subsection (a); and
- 14 (2) one sheriff of a county with a population below the
- 15 median population size to serve as an ex officio nonvoting member
- 16 under Subsection (a).
- 17 (c) A sheriff who is made a member of a governing body in
- 18 <u>accordance with this section</u> may designate a representative to
- 19 serve as a member of the body in the sheriff's place as an ex
- 20 officio nonvoting member under Subsection (a). Except as provided
- 21 by Subsection (c-1), a sheriff or the designated representative of
- 22 the sheriff serves as an ex officio nonvoting member under
- 23 Subsection (a) for the duration of the applicable sheriff's term
- 24 in office.
- (c-1) A local mental health authority may rotate the
- 26 positions of sheriffs who serve as ex officio nonvoting members
- [as] chosen in accordance with Subsection (b) among the other

- 1 sheriffs of the counties served by the local authority. A local
- 2 authority shall consult with each sheriff of the counties served
- 3 by the local authority in rotating the positions of sheriffs
- 4 serving as ex officio nonvoting members under this subsection.
- 5 (c-2) A local mental health authority shall allow a sheriff
- 6 selected under this section to be a voting member of the governing
- 7 board upon request of the sheriff, pursuant to the sheriff agreeing
- 8 to comply with all standards and rules applicable to voting board
- 9 members.
- 10 (c-3) A person employed by a local mental health authority
- 11 may not serve as a member of the authority's governing body.
- 12 SECTION 4. Subchapter B, Chapter 533, Health and Safety
- 13 Code, is amended by adding Section 533.0355 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 533.0355. PROHIBITION ON DIVERSITY, EQUITY, AND
- 15 INCLUSION INITIATIVES IN LOCAL MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITIES. (a) In
- 16 <u>this s</u>ection:
- 17 (1) "Diversity, equity, and inclusion initiative" means
- 18 an initiative that:
- 19 (A) is based on the belief that identity
- 20 classifications are central to understanding social, professional,
- 21 and political disparities;
- 22 (B) requires, encourages, or otherwise promotes
- 23 organizational practices such as employee hiring and promotion,
- 24 resource allocation, or policy formulation to achieve proportional
- 25 representation of identity classification groups or to eliminate
- 26 perceived systemic differences between them; or
- 27 (C) otherwise promotes discriminatory treatment

- 1 of a person on the basis of the person's identity classification.
- 2 (2) "Identity classification" means a classification of
- 3 a person based on the race, color, religion, national origin, or
- 4 ethnicity of the person.
- 5 (b) A local mental health authority may not, except to the
- 6 extent required by federal law:
- 7 (1) formulate, promote, or implement a diversity,
- 8 equity, and inclusion initiative; or
- 9 (2) give preference on the basis of an identity
- 10 classification to an applicant for employment, an employee, or a
- 11 participant in any function of the local mental health authority.
- SECTION 5. Section 533.0351 (e), Health and Safety Code is
- 13 repealed.
- SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
