4	AN ACT
5	relating to protections for certain military dependents
6	enrolled in a public school.
7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
8	SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as "Rocky's Law".
9	SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 25, Education Code,
10	is amended by adding Section 25.906 to read as follows:
11	Sec. 25.906. PROTECTIONS FOR CERTAIN MILITARY
12	DEPENDENTS. (a) In this section:
13	(1) "Compact" means the Interstate Compact or
14	Educational Opportunity for Military Children executed
15	under Section 162.002.
16	(2) "Uniformed services" means:
17	(A) the United States Army, Navy, Air Force,
18	Space Force, Marine Corps, National Guard and Reserves, or
19	Coast Guard;
20	(B) the Commissioned Corps of the National
21	Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration; or

- 1 (C) the Commissioned Corps of the United
- 2 States Public Health Service.
- 3 (b) The provisions of Articles IV, V, VI, and VII of
- 4 the Compact apply to the following children as if those
- 5 children were children described by Article III of the
- 6 Compact:
- 7 (1) a child of a veteran of the uniformed
- 8 services who was discharged or released through retirement,
- 9 for a period of four years after the date of the veteran's
- 10 retirement, if the veteran returns to the veteran's home
- 11 of record on military orders; and
- 12 (2) a child of a member of the uniformed services
- 13 who dies on active duty or as a result of injuries sustained
- on active duty, for a period of four years after the
- 15 member's death.
- 16 (c) Each school district and open-enrollment charter
- 17 school that maintains an Internet website shall post on the
- 18 district's or school's Internet website an easily
- 19 accessible link to information regarding the Compact and
- 20 the additional protections provided by this section. This
- 21 tab should be simply labeled "MIC3" under the district's
- or school's main menu.

- 1 (d) The Texas Education Agency's Compact Council
- 2 shall include a current or former Department of Defense
- 3 Education Activity teacher.
- 4 (e) No personnel with criminal arrest records
- 5 involving assault upon family, unrelated individuals or
- 6 minors can work at any school that serves military-
- 7 connected students.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-
- 9 2026 school year.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 11 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected
- 12 to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III,
- 13 Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote
- 14 necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect
- 15 September 1, 2025.
